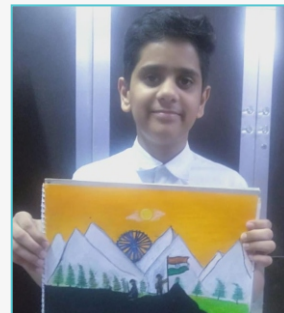

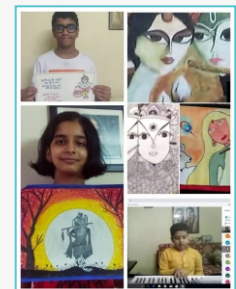
Independence Day

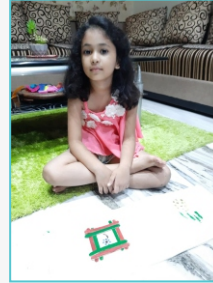
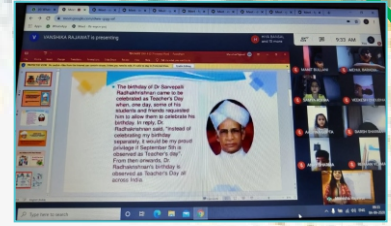
On the auspicious occasion of Rakshabandhan, the students of Bubbles and Primary Wing made beautiful eco-friendly rakhis.

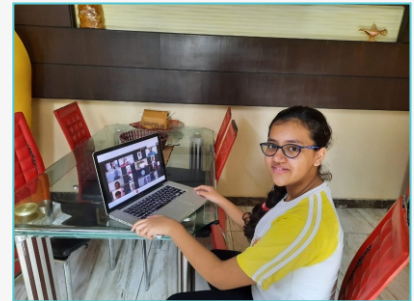
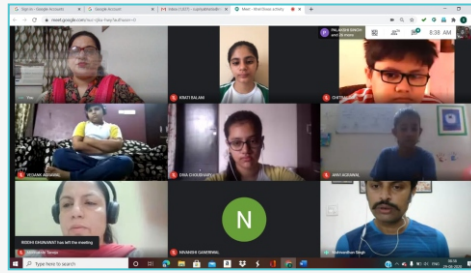
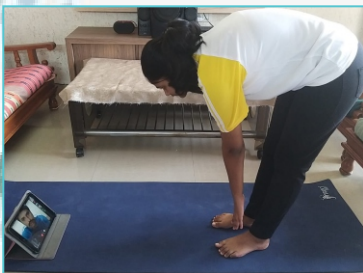
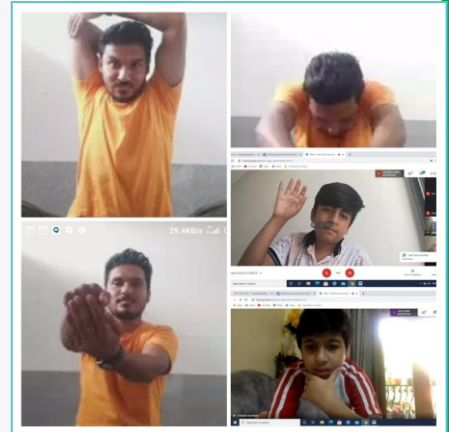
Teachers' Day

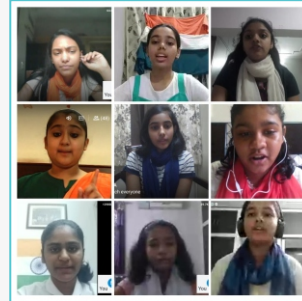
ACTIVITIES

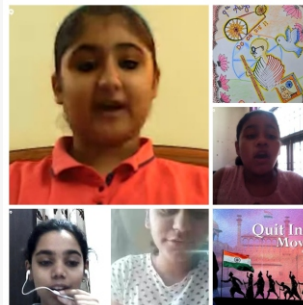

ART INTEGRATED LEARNING

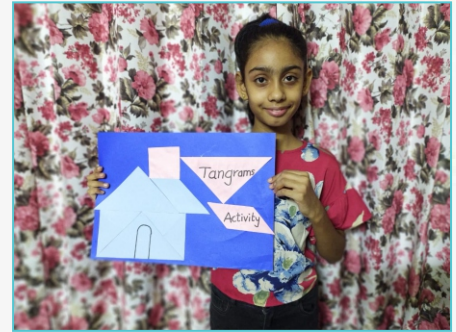

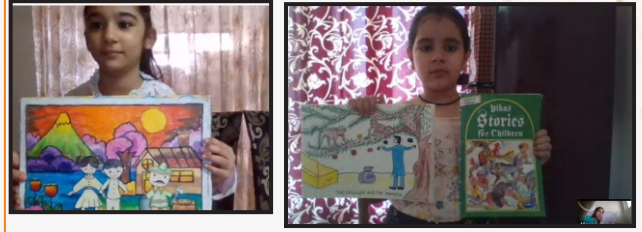
LITERARY WEEK

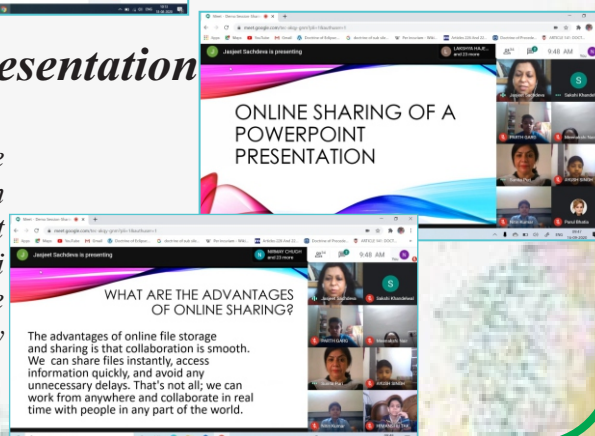
Instrumental Song Activity
