More than 400 delegates from various schools of Jaipur participated in a conference to deliberate, debate and to inspire action towards creating a more humane and peaceful world. The event was vibrant and impactful which allowed the young delegates to understand and confront the world's challenges and explore plausible solutions.
- ❖ XI Maharaja Sawai Bhawani Singh Memorial Tournament was organised from 6th 9th November 2023 at the school Sports Grounds. V. ACTIVITIES

CBSE ACTIVITIES

- 1) **Student Innovation Council:** The school conducted various online Student Innovation Council activities with Classes XI and XII like Leadership Talk, Motivational Sessions by successful entrepreneurs on Entrepreneurship and Startup support ecosystem in the country, Intellectual Property Rights and technology transfer organized by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell. The school has also participated in National School Innovation Contest where the students of classes IX to XII have submitted innovative ideas, their prototypes and business models. One of the ideas FEEDISH, a device attached to an aquarium to provide food to fishes at regular intervals, was selected for the Online Pitching Competition.
- 2) **World Health Day**: Raising awareness about physical health and mental well-being, MSBSS Celebrated WORLD HEALTH DAY on April 7, 2023, under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman by conducting various activities for the students of Classes VI to VIII focusing on the importance of millets. The students participated with great enthusiasm and zeal by bringing meals made from millets to school. The teachers held interactive sessions in their respective classrooms and shared the following key points with the students:
 - importance of millets
 - value of healthy and balanced diet
 - * malnutrition and its impact on society
 - healthy food habits and harmful effects of junk foods

- 3) **Stay Safe Online Campaign**: With the goal of raising awareness among students about how to stay safe online due to widespread use of social media platforms and rapid adoption of digital payments, the students in classes VI to XII were involved in various activities every month until November 2023. These activities included Poster Making, Slogan Writing, Quiz, Debates and Declamation. Information was imparted through interactive sessions and creating Powerpoint presentations.
- 4) **Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav**: To commemorate 75 years of India's independence, the Ministry of Culture conceived a campaign named "Meri Mati Mera Desh," set to mark the culmination of the Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav. This campaign was a tribute to the valorous Veers who made the ultimate sacrifice for our country. Special assemblies were organized to create awareness among the students. They also wrote articles on the same.
- Seeding Month: To promote the culture of reading, MSBSS conducted various activities as suggested in the Circular-Acad-68/2023 amongst the students of classes VI-VIII. The school promoted 'Group Reading' enabling mutual teaching and learning both formally and unconsciously. Poems were recited and stories were narrated by the students which helped them in improving memorization power and promoted creative thinking. Students were encouraged to donate books to help the underprivileged. All these activities helped the school to propagate the message of 'Read and Grow' among all the students.
